

COOKIES

A cookie is a small piece of data that a website asks the browser of each visitor on our website to store on his or her computer or mobile device. The cookie allows the website to “remember” the visitor’s actions or preferences over time. Cookies do not give Katalysta access to the computer/mobile device or any other information about the visitor. They only improve the visitor’s interaction with the website. Cookies do not contain any information that personally identifies the visitor, but personal information that Katalysta stores about the users may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies. By logging in, each visitor agrees with the cookies used for the website (Google Analytics). Our website may use cookies to track the number of times a user has visited the website, to track the number of visitors of the website, to determine and analyze visitors’ use of our website, to store technical information related to a visitor’s interactions with our website. If a visitor blocks cookies, he or she will not be able to use all the features of our website. A visitor can also delete cookies already stored on a visitor’s computer or mobile device. By doing this, a visitor may impact negatively on his or her usability of the website.
